These initial-level roles are needed for one of the most linguistically diverse locations in the world. Do you see yourself as more than a behind-a-desk linguist? Are you up for an exciting challenge? Are you a self-motivated team player who finds enjoyment working in a multicultural environment? This is the kind of person we're seeking. One absolute necessity is having a committed prayer team. By serving on our team, you would be reaching out to several language communities without known believers. There are also some challenges: linguistic complexity; the political, religious, and socio-economic environment, including the process of obtaining a visa. Yet the joy that comes from seeing lives transformed transcends all these challenges!

Main responsibilities:

- Learning the national language and culture, then learning the target language and culture
- Working in a team to set goals, plan, and organize your tasks
- Carrying out language analysis as a team and writing up your findings, laying the foundation for translation work
- Building relationships and a strong translation team, providing exegetical input for translators from the community

MEDITERRANEAN REGION – TRANSLATION COORDINATOR

Do you have experience in a translation project? Are your organizational and communication skills strong? Would you like a part-time role that could be carried out remotely? While the main focus of a Translation Coordinator is to coordinate the work of the region's Translation Consultants, the activities of this role are varied and critical for the good functioning of our translation teams in the region.

- Ensuring that the work of the Translation Consultants is distributed fairly and that teams receive their services as needed
- Collecting and reviewing translation checking reports
- Overseeing translation consultant development
- Relating to field staff as well as to the Area Translation Coordinator
- Engaging in short-term research tasks that will benefit translation teams

MEDITERRANEAN – LANGUAGE TECHNOLOGY SPECIALIST

Part-time (0.50 FTE); onsite, western Europe, or elsewhere

Are you innovative? Can you work well in teams? Are you good at communicating? Do you have a strong desire to share in God's work in a creative access environment? Language technology, which includes apps and other forms of digital media, can reach communities that might never otherwise be able to access Scripture in a form they can understand or accept. Much of this work requires English, but the ability to speak or learn another Mediterranean-region language may be helpful. The role calls for some travel and a commitment to serve at least 3 years. This position can be combined with the IT Support Specialist position (see below), also 0.50 FTE, to provide a full-time role.

Main responsibilities:

- Helping create mobile apps for Scripture, literacy, dictionaries, and keyboards
- Staying up-to-date with the latest recommended software
- Providing technical support for staff using language technology software, including installation, training, maintenance, and guidance
- Assisting staff in archiving language materials
- Sending Scriptures and updates to the Digital Bible Library

MEDITERRANEAN - MULTI-SKILLED IT SPECIALIST

Part-time (0.50 FTE); onsite, western Europe, or elsewhere

Do you have technical IT skills and experience? Are you an excellent communicator? Do you enjoy collaborating on a team? We're seeking a Multi-skilled IT Specialist to bless a team working across eleven time zones, serving sensitive-environment language groups. One look at the list below, and you'll see that the role could not be boring! Much of this work requires English, but the ability to speak or learn another Mediterranean-region language may be helpful. The role calls for some travel and a commitment to serve at least 3 years. This position plus the Language Technology Specialist position (above), also 0.50 FTE, provides full-time engagement.

- Fielding support requests re: hardware, software, operating systems, internet, email, etc.
- Maintaining best practice guidelines for software, apps, web services, and data safety
- Keeping up to date on IT issues, regularly informing colleagues of relevant developments
- Helping formulate policies related to IT use and security
- Maintaining the team's internal website, various types of email systems, data backups, security platforms, and Scripture distribution technologies



MEDITERRANEAN - ANIMATOR/ARTIST

Do you have a degree (or equivalent) in animation, graphic art, illustration, or a related discipline? If you have 2-3 years of relevant work experience, that's even better! Are you willing to learn new skills, as needed? Our animation team must grow in order to produce animated videos of one Old Testament book and one Gospel during the next few years. These animations are for reaching audiences that would never pick up a book. Making culturally appropriate animations requires training in cultural anthropology and ethno-arts. Taking at least two years to study the language and culture in this Mediterranean region will be time well spent for a project that will last a minimum of 3-4 years. Are you up for an exciting, engaging challenge – helping people interact with God's Word in a form they can understand and accept?

Main responsibilities:

- Being trained in anthropology and ethno-arts
- Studying language and culture in the region
- Learning new skills as necessary
- Bringing your own skills to the team to help produce two animated videos

WEST ASIA – SCRIPTURE ENGAGEMENT WORKER
